PE undertakes plant building construction and equipment and tooling preparation for mass production. Purchasing oversees the procurement of more than €3 billion of parts and materials each year. Technical Centre also houses a part of Toyota Motor Europe's Information Systems division. The newly added Production Styling function kicked off in 2016.
